

Bottoms up mobile bars

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

An invoice for the deposit shall be sent to the client immediately upon an order being placed. This invoice should be paid in full. The client shall also be aware that the hire is not confirmed until the deposit is received.

The deposit is refundable on the night as long as over the negotiated number of guests over the age of 18 attend the event. If the number of guests has not been negotiated this should be assumed to be 120. In the event that the number of guests in attendance is less than agreed, Bottoms Up Mobile Bars reserves the right to withhold the deposit.

All beverages consumed at the event MUST be purchased from Bottoms Up Mobile Bars unless a prior arrangement has been reached.

All cancellations will result in the loss of the deposit.

Bottoms Up Mobile bars will endeavour to install and remove any equipment by the times requested by the client/venue, but cannot be held responsible for any delays however caused.

Bottoms Up Mobile Bars will refuse service to anyone its staff deems unfit to be served.

A customer will be refused service when:

- The customer is under 18 or cannot prove their age.
- The customer is deemed drunk.
- The customer is verbally or physically abusive.

Bottoms Up Mobile Bars will NOT tolerate any form of verbal or physical abuse and reserves the right to withdraw its services/equipment if the situation arises.

The responsibilities of the client

The client shall provide clear indication as to where the equipment should be placed. Alternatively Bottoms Up Mobile Bars will set up where it sees fit.

Only Bottoms Up Mobile Bars shall have authorisation to alter any part of the equipment prior to, during or post installation i.e. the removal of pipes or relocation of gas bottles is NOT permitted.

Third party liability

Bottoms Up Mobile Bars will not be responsible for, and the client will indemnify the company against all claims for injury to persons or loss or damage to property however caused unless it is proved that such injury or damage resulted from faulty materials, workmanship or negligence.

Force Majeure

If Bottoms Up Mobile Bars has applied for a Temporary events notice but it is refused by the council or police, Bottoms Up Mobile Bars WILL refund the deposit but cannot be held responsible for the non-completion of the order.

Whilst every effort will be made by the company to complete any orders, the company cannot be held liable for non-completion of orders due to matters beyond its control.
